## **Police assures action after** residents meet SHO



Recent spate of crime has left the residents scared

round 50 residents Aincluding members of the Confederation of Residents Welfare Associations (CRWA) from sectors 28, 29 and 30 met SHO Ratandeep Bali of Sector 31 police station to discuss the security issues in these sectors. The number of theft cases in sectors 28, 29 and 30 have increased manifold in the recent past and have caused panic among the residents.

CRWA general secretary AS Gulati said, "The spate of crimes in the last two weeks has left the residents scared. The number of cases of auto lifting and robberies has increased. This upsurge in crime is attributed mainly to lack of police patrolling in the area. Barricades should also be set up at strategic points in the sectors as precautionary measures."

Sector 29 (HUDA) RWA general secretary Subodh Nagpal said, "The crimes

have incre ased in the last few days.

As the gates remain open, residents find it difficult to be alert all the time without police patrolling. Four theft cases were registered in our sector alone but when we complained to the police they cited staff shortage problem."

Sector 30 RWA president IK Banga and former general secretary Ravi Kapoor also visited the police station.
